INDEKS HARGA PENGGUNA (IHP), APRIL 2014

1. Indeks Harga Pengguna (IHP) bagi bulan April 2014 meningkat 0.4 peratus berbanding Mac 2014.
2. Peningkatan sebanyak 1.0 peratus telah dicatatkan bagi Pengangkutan disebabkan oleh harga yang tinggi bagi kenderaan, alat ganti dan aksesori kenderaan serta perkhidmatan pengangkutan melalui udara. Pelbagai Barangan dan Perkhidmatan meningkat 1.3 peratus disebabkan oleh kos yang tinggi bagi barangan untuk kebersihan diri, produk kecantikan dan barangan serta beg perjalanan. Perhiasan, Peralatan Isi Rumah dan Penyelenggaraan Rutin Isi Rumah juga meningkat 0.8 peratus disebabkan oleh harga yang tinggi bagi kebanyakan perabot, tekstil isi rumah, dan peralatan rumah.
3. Sementara itu, penurunan sebanyak 0.4 peratus telah dicatatkan bagi Makanan dan Minuman Ringan disebabkan oleh harga yang rendah bagi sayur dan ikan segar terpilih serta ayam segar. Rekreasi dan Kebudayaan juga menurun sebanyak 0.2 peratus disebabkan oleh penurunan harga bagi peralatan audio-visual, komputer dan aksesori komputer serta pakej percutian dan umrah.
4. IHP bagi April 2014 meningkat 0.2 peratus berbanding April 2013 yang mana sebahagian besarnya disebabkan oleh peningkatan indeks Pengangkutan; Restoran dan Hotel; dan Pendidikan.

5. IHP ini adalah petunjuk bagi mengukur perubahan harga barangan dan perkhidmatan yang dibayar oleh pengguna dalam satu tempoh masa tertentu. Senarai barangan dan perkhidmatan dalam IHP adalah berasaskan maklumat perbelanjaan purata sebuah keluarga yang diperolehi melalui Kajian Perbelanjaan Keluarga. CONSUMER PRICE INDEX (CPI), APRIL 2014

1. *The Consumer Price Index (CPI) for April 2014 increased by 0.4 per cent over March 2014.*
2. *An increase of 1.0 per cent was recorded in Transport due to the higher prices of motor cars, spare parts and accessories of vehicles as well as passenger transport services by air. Miscellaneous Goods and Services increased by 1.3 per cent due to higher cost of articles for personal hygiene, beauty products and travel goods and bags. Furnishing, Household Equipment and Routine Household Maintenance also increased by 0.8 per cent due to higher cost of other furniture, other household textiles and utensils.*
3. *On the other hand, a decrease of 0.4 per cent was recorded in Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages due to lower prices of selected fresh leafy vegetables and fish as well as fresh chicken. Recreation and Culture also decreased by 0.2 per cent due to lower prices of audio-visual equipment, computers and computer accessories as well as package holidays and pilgrimages.*
4. *CPI for April 2014 increased by 0.2 per cent compared to April 2013, largely due to the higher index for Transport; Restaurants and Hotels; and Education.*

5. *CPI is a measure of price changes of goods and services paid by the consumer in a specified period. The list of goods and services in the CPI is based on the average expenditure per household from the Household Expenditure Survey.
