INDEKS HARGA PENGGUNA (IHP), MEI 2014

1. Indeks Harga Pengguna (IHP) bagi bulan Mei 2014 menurun 0.5 peratus berbanding April 2014.
2. Penurunan sebanyak 3.8 peratus telah dicatatkan bagi Pakaian dan Kasut disebabkan oleh harga yang rendah bagi beberapa jenis pakaian dan baju terpilih, lain-lain keperluan untuk pakaian dan kasut. Perhiasan, Peralatan Isi Rumah dan Penyelenggaraan Rutin Isi Rumah menurun 1.2 peratus disebabkan oleh penurunan harga bagi kebanyakan perabot, tekstil isi rumah, peralatan dan kelengkapan isi rumah. Makanan dan Minuman Ringan juga menurun 0.4 peratus disebabkan oleh harga yang rendah bagi produk tenusu dan telur, buah-buahan, sayur, ayam segar serta ikan segar terpilih.
3. Sementara itu, peningkatan kurang dari 0.05 peratus telah dicatatkan bagi Pangangkutan disebabkan oleh harga yang tinggi bagi pembelian kenderaan.
4. IHP bagi Mei 2014 menurun 0.2 peratus berbanding Mei 2013 yang mana sebahagian besarnya disebabkan oleh peningkatan indeks Perhiasan, Peralatan Isi Rumah dan Penyelenggaraan Rutin Isi Rumah; Rekreasi dan Kebudayaan; dan Pakaian dan Kasut.

5. IHP ini adalah petunjuk bagi mengukur perubahan harga barangan dan perkhidmatan yang dibayar oleh pengguna dalam satu tempoh masa tertentu. Senarai barangan dan perkhidmatan dalam IHP adalah berasaskan maklumat perbelanjaan purata sebuah keluarga yang diperolehi melalui Kajian Perbelanjaan Keluarga. CONSUMER PRICE INDEX (CPI), MAY 2014

1. *The Consumer Price Index (CPI) for May 2014 decreased by 0.5 per cent over April 2014.*
2. *An decrease of 3.8 per cent was recorded in Clothing and Footwear due to lower prices of several selected garments, other articles of clothing as well as shoes and other footwear. Furnishing, Household Equipment and Routine Household Maintenance decreased by 1.2 per cent due to higher cost of other furniture, other household textiles, tools and utensils of household. Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages also decreased by 0.4 per cent due to lower prices of selected dairy products and eggs, fruit, vegetables, fresh chicken as well as selected fish.*
3. *On the other hand, an increase of less than 0.05 per cent was recorded in Transport due to higher cost of purchase of motor car.*
4. *CPI for May 2014 decreased by 0.2 per cent compared to May 2013, largely due to higher index for Furnishing, Household Equipment and Routine Household Maintenance; Recreation and Culture; and Clothing and Footwear.*

5. *CPI is a measure of price changes of goods and services paid by the consumer in a specified period. The list of goods and services in the CPI is based on the average expenditure per household from the Household Expenditure Survey.
