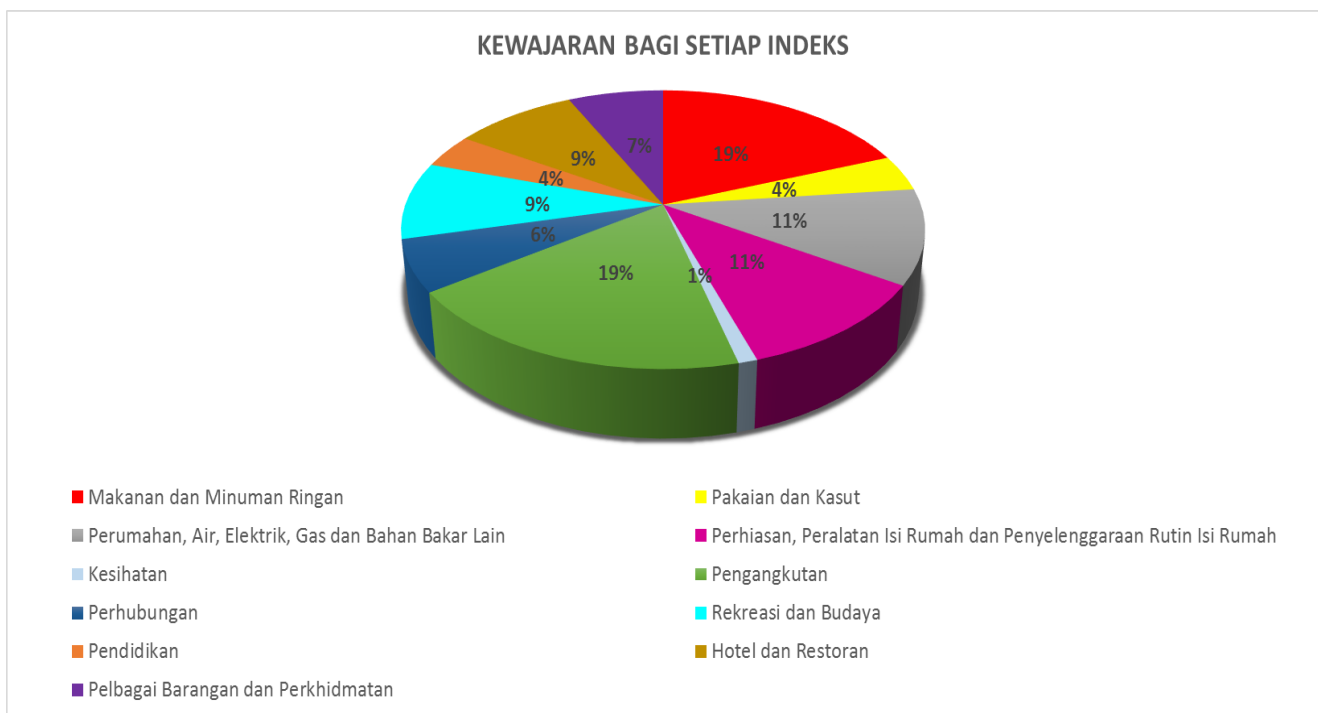

INDEKS HARGA PENGGUNA (IHP), OKTOBER 2016

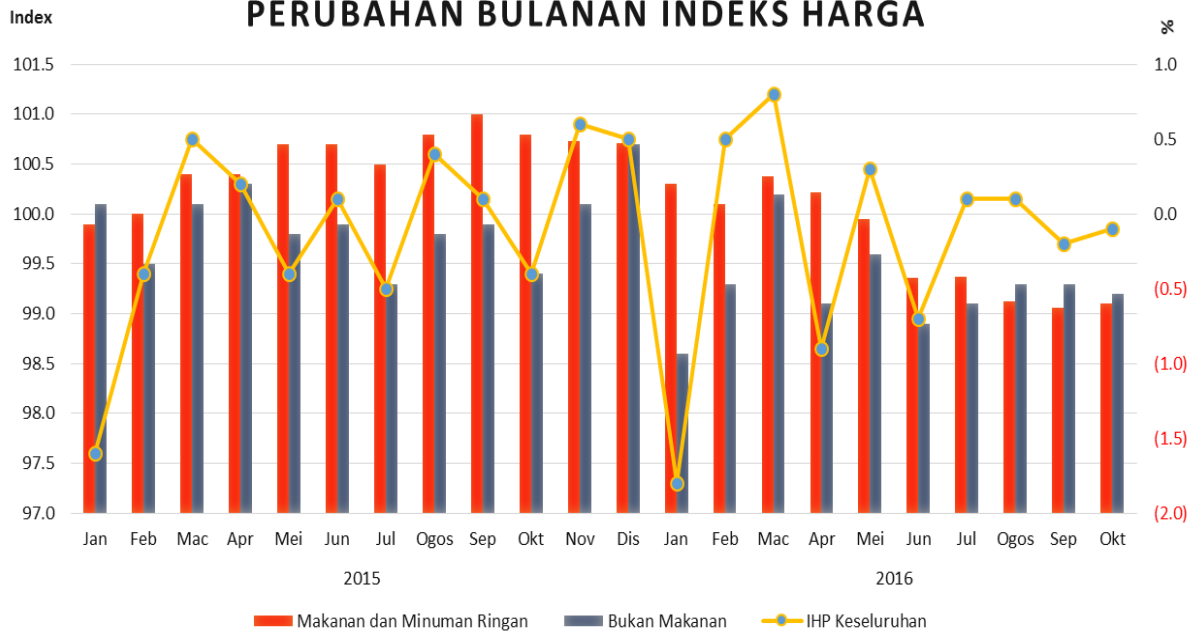
1. Indeks Harga Pengguna (IHP) bagi bulan Oktober 2016 meningkat sebanyak 0.1 peratus berbanding bulan lepas September 2016. Indeks Makanan dan Minuman Ringan dan Indeks Bukan Makanan masing-masing mencatatkan peningkatan sebanyak 0.1 peratus.
2. Peningkatan Indeks keseluruhan bagi bulan Oktober 2016 adalah disebabkan oleh kenaikan harga bagi Pakaian dan Kasut sebanyak 3.5 peratus, diikuti oleh Pelbagai Barangan dan Perkhidmatan (0.7 peratus) dan Makanan dan Minuman Ringan (0.1 peratus).
3. Indeks yang mencatatkan penurunan pada bulan ini adalah Perhiasan, Peralatan Isi Rumah dan Penyelenggaraan Rutin Isi Rumah (0.9 peratus), Pengangkutan (0.3 peratus) dan Perhubungan (0.2 peratus). Penurunan ini adalah berikutan harga rendah terutamanya bagi perabot dan perhiasan, pengangkutan penumpang melalui udara dan juga peralatan telefon dan telefaks.
4. Manakala Indeks bagi Perumahan, Air, Elektrik, Gas dan Bahan Bakar Lain, Pendidikan serta Restoran dan Hotel tidak mencatatkan sebarang perubahan.
5. Berbanding dengan Oktober 2015, IHP bagi Oktober 2016 telah menurun sebanyak 0.5 peratus. Sementara itu bagi tempoh Januari 2016 hingga Oktober 2016 kini, IHP menurun secara purata 0.6 peratus.
6. IHP mengukur perubahan harga barangan dan perkhidmatan yang dibayar oleh pengguna dalam satu tempoh masa ditetapkan dan dikumpulkan setiap bulan. Senarai barangan dan perkhidmatan dalam IHP adalah berdasarkan maklumat perbelanjaan purata sebuah keluarga yang diperolehi melalui Kajian Perbelanjaan Keluarga. CONSUMER PRICE INDEX (CPI), OCTOBER 2016

1. *Consumer Price Index (CPI) in October 2016 rose by 0.1 per cent over September 2016, whereby both Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages and Non-Food Index increased by 0.1 per cent.*
2. *The increase in overall CPI in October 2016 was due to higher prices of Clothing and Footwear, by 3.5 per cent followed by Miscellaneous Goods and Services (0.7 per cent) and Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages (0.1 per cent).*
3. *Indexes that experience decreases are Furnishings, Household Equipment and Routine Household Maintenance by 0.9 per cent, Transport (0.3 per cent) and Communication (0.2 per cent). The decreases were due to lower prices of furniture and furnishings, passenger transport by air and telephone and telefax equipment.*
4. *Meanwhile, indices for Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas & Other Fuels, Education and Restaurants and Hotels remained unchanged.*
5. *Compared to October 2015, the CPI for October 2016 declined by 0.5 per cent. Meanwhile, for the period from January 2016 to October 2016, the CPI has decreased on average by 0.6 per cent.*
6. *CPI is a measure of price changes of goods and services paid by the consumer in a specified period and compiled on a monthly basis. The list of goods and services in the CPI is based on the average expenditure per household from the Household Expenditure Survey.
