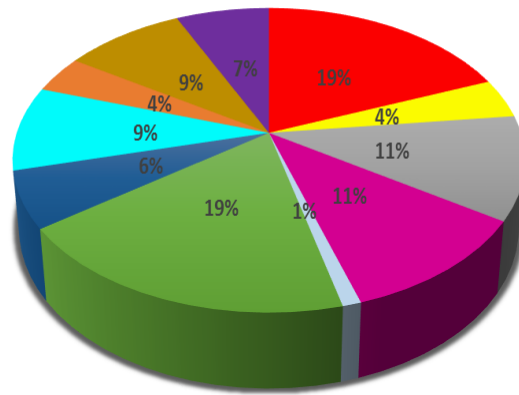
INDEKS HARGA PENGGUNA (IHP), MAC 2017

1. Indeks Harga Pengguna (IHP) bagi bulan Mac 2017 meningkat kurang dari 0.05 peratus berbanding bulan Februari 2017. Indeks Makanan dan Minuman Ringan menurun sebanyak 0.3 peratus manakala indeks Bukan Makanan pula meningkat sebanyak 0.1 peratus.
2. Peningkatan Indeks keseluruhan bagi bulan Mac 2017 sebahagiannya disebabkan oleh indeks Pengangkutan (1.7 peratus); Pelbagai Barangan dan Perkhidmatan (kurang dari 0.05 peratus) diikuti oleh indeks Restoran dan Hotel (kurang dari 0.05 peratus). Ini adalah berikutan harga tinggi bagi pengangkutan penumpang melalui udara; peralatan dan produk penjagaan diri; dan juga perkhidmatan penginapan.
3. Indeks yang mencatatkan penurunan pula adalah Rekreasi dan Kebudayaan (1.3 peratus); Makanan dan Minuman Ringan (0.3 peratus); Perhiasan, Peralatan Isi Rumah dan Penyelenggaraan Rutin Isi Rumah (0.5 peratus); dan Pakaian dan Kasut (1.0 peratus).
4. Manakala Indeks Perumahan, Air, Elektrik, Gas dan Bahan Bakar Lain dan Indeks Pendidikan tidak mencatatkan sebarang perubahan.
5. Bagi perubahan tahun ke tahun pula, IHP bagi Mac 2017 telah menurun sebanyak 0.9 peratus berbanding dengan Mac 2016. Indeks Makanan dan Minuman Ringan dan indeks Bukan Makanan masing-masing mencatatkan penurunan sebanyak 1.2 peratus dan 0.9 peratus.
6. IHP mengukur perubahan harga barangan dan perkhidmatan yang dibayar oleh pengguna dalam satu tempoh masa ditetapkan dan dikumpulkan setiap bulan. Senarai barangan dan perkhidmatan dalam IHP adalah berdasarkan maklumat perbelanjaan purata sebuah keluarga yang diperolehi melalui Kajian Perbelanjaan Keluarga. 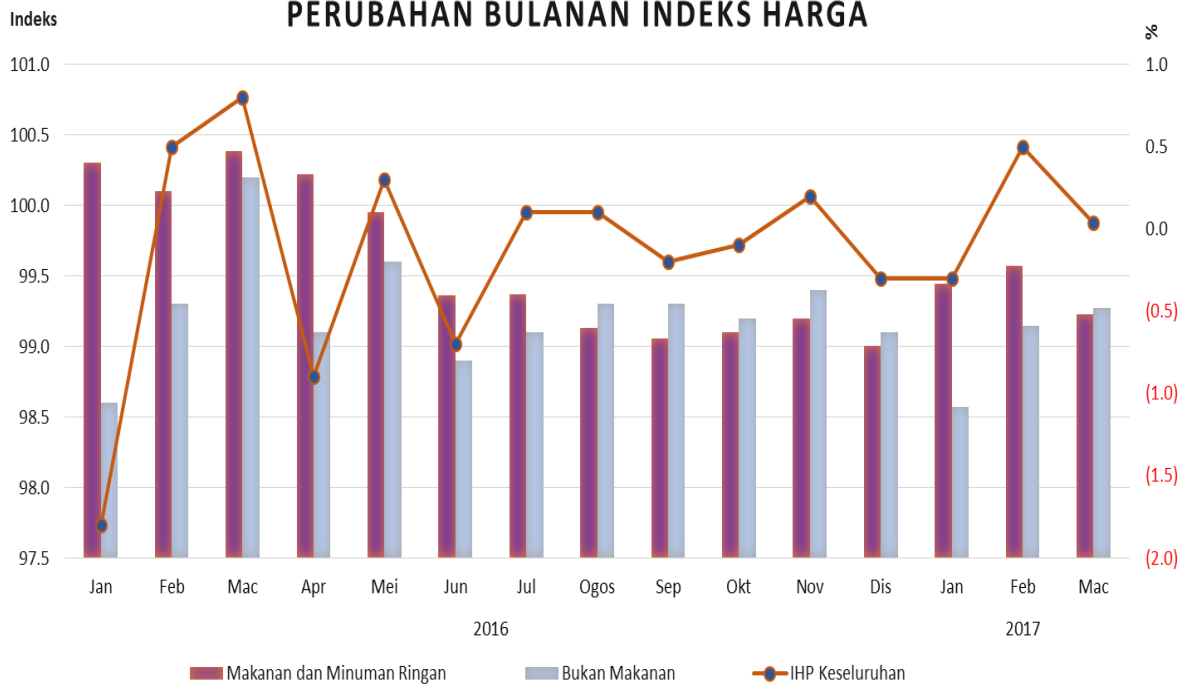

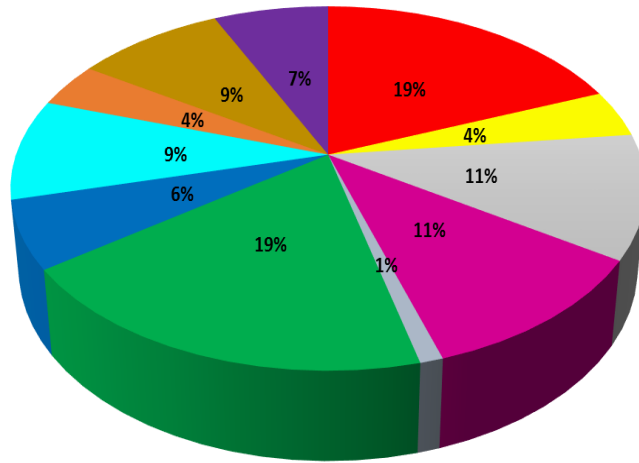
CONSUMER PRICE INDEX (CPI), MARCH 2017

1. *Consumer Price Index (CPI) in March 2017 increased slightly by less than 0.05 per cent over February 2017. Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages Index decreased by 0.3 percent while Non-Food Index increased by 0.1 per cent.*
2. *The slight increase in the overall CPI in March 2017 was largely contributed by Transport (1.7 per cent); Miscellaneous Goods & Services (less than 0.05 per cent) followed by Restaurants & Hotels (less than 0.05 per cent). These were mainly due to higher prices of passenger transport by air; other appliances articles and products for personal care as well as accommodation services.*
3. *Indices that experienced decreases were Recreation & Culture (1.3 per cent); Food & Non-Alcoholic Beverages (0.3 per cent); Furnishings, Household Equipment & Routine Maintenance (0.5 per cent); and Clothing and Footwear (1.0 per cent).*
4. *Meanwhile, Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas & Other Fuels and Education Index remained unchanged.*
5. *On a year-on-year basis, the CPI for March 2017 has declined by 0.9 per cent compared to March 2016. Both Food & Non-Alcoholic Beverages and Non Food Index decreased by 1.2 per cent and 0.9 per cent, respectively.*
6. *CPI is a measure of price changes of goods and services paid by the consumer in a specified period and compiled on a monthly basis. The list of goods and services in the CPI is based on the average expenditure per household from the Household Expenditure Survey.
