**MESYUARAT JAWATANKUASA SISTEM STATISTIK KOMUNITI ASEAN**  
**SESI KESEBELAS (ACSS11), 12 – 14 OKTOBER 2021**

1. Mesyuarat Jawatankuasa Sistem Statistik Komuniti ASEAN Sesi Kesebelas (ACSS11) telah diadakan pada 12 hingga 14 Oktober 2021 secara maya. Mesyuarat telah dipengerusikan oleh Yang Mulia Dayang Hajah Mariah binti Haji Yahya, Ketua Pengarah, Jabatan Perancangan Ekonomi dan Statistik (JPES), Kementerian Kewangan dan Ekonomi dan Puan Hang Lina, Ketua Pengarah, *National Institute of Statistics* (NIS), Cambodia selaku Pengerusi Bersama. Negara Brunei Darussalam diwakili oleh pegawai-pegawai kanan dari Jabatan Perangkaan, JPES.
2. Jawatankuasa ACSS yang terdiri dari Ketua-Ketua Pejabat Perangkaan Kebangsaan dari Negara-negara anggota ASEAN (AMS) bertanggungjawab dalam penyediaan statistik ASEAN yang relevan, betepatan masa dan sebanding bagi menyokong pemantauan integrasi ASEAN serta pembuatan keputusan dan dasar berasaskan data dan fakta. Di samping itu, ACSS juga berperanan dalam mengukuhkan kerjasama untuk meningkatkan keupayaan statistik AMS dan Sekretariat ASEAN.
3. Dalam mendukung tema ASEAN pada tahun ini, *'We Care, We Prepare, We Prosper'*, program kerja ACSS11 memfokuskan kepada *"Building Resilient Statistics to COVID-19 Recovery and Beyond"*. Mesyuarat antarlain membincangkan mengenai pelaksanaan, perkembangan dan pencapaian pelan kerja statistik, serta pelaksanaan Data Terbuka (*Open Data*). Mesyuarat juga mengesahkan Nota Konsep bagi Projek Perintis Penggunaan Big Data (*Pilot Project of Big Data Utilisation*) yang bertujuan untuk meningkatkan potensi penggunaan *Big Data* sebagai sumber data baharu dalam perangkaan rasmi ASEAN.

4. Mesyuarat juga mengambil maklum mengenai kejayaan ACSS di dalam pelaksanaan *ASEAN-Help-ASEAN Framework* untuk pembangunan kapasiti dengan mengadakan program kursus dan latihan serta memudahcara perkongsian pengetahuan dan pengalaman di antara AMS bagi mempercepatkan perkembangan pengetahuan statistik di peringkat nasional dan serantau.
5. Mesyuarat tersebut turut bertukar pandangan dan pengalaman mengenai cabaran dan impak pandemik COVID-19 terhadap aktiviti pengumpulan statistik serta inisiatif masing-masing dalam mengenal pasti peluang baharu untuk pembangunan daya tahan dalam pengeluaran dan penyebaran statistik melalui pelbagai pendekatan termasuk penggunaan teknologi digital.

***THE ELEVENTH SESSION OF THE ASEAN COMMUNITY STATISTICAL  
SYSTEMS COMMITTEE (ACSS11), 12 – 14 OCTOBER 2021***

1. The Eleventh Session of the ASEAN Community Statistical System Committee (ACSS11) was held virtually on 12th to 14th October 2021. The Session was chaired by Yang Mulia Dayang Hajah Mariah binti Haji Yahya, Director General, Department of Economic Planning and Statistics (DEPS), Ministry of Finance and Economy and Madam Hang Lina, Director General of the National Institute of Statistics (NIS), Cambodia served as the Co-chairperson. Brunei Darussalam was represented by senior officers from the Department of Statistics, DEPS.
2. The ACSS Committee, comprising Heads of National Statistics Offices (NSOs) from ASEAN Member States (AMS), is responsible in providing relevant, timely and comparable ASEAN statistics in support of ASEAN integration monitoring and evidence-based policy and decision making. In addition, ACSS plays a role in strengthening its cooperation to enhance statistical capacities of the AMS and the ASEAN Secretariat.
3. In support of this year's ASEAN theme, 'We Care, We Prepare, We Prosper', the ACSS11 work program focuses on "Building Resilient Statistics to COVID-19 Recovery and Beyond". The meeting discussed amongst others the implementation, development and achievements of the statistical work plan, and the implementation of Open Data. The meeting also endorsed the Concept Note on the Pilot Project of Big Data Utilisation to be implemented in 2022 with the objective to enhance the potential use of Big Data as new sources of data in ASEAN official statistics.

4. The meeting took note of the ACSS achievement in implementing the ASEAN-Help-ASEAN Framework for capacity building by conducting various training courses and programmes and facilitating greater knowledge and experience sharing among AMSs to speed up the development of statistics at national and regional levels.
5. The meeting also exchanged views and experiences on the challenges and impact of the COVID-19 pandemic on statistical collection activities as well as respective initiatives in identifying new opportunities for the development of resilience in the production and dissemination of statistics through various approaches including the use of digital technology.
